### 8AM CORNER ROOM

Part of the impressive Town Hall Hotel in Bethnal Green, this atmospheric restaurant is a great place for breakfast. Weekend brunch includes highlights such as Cornish crab eggs Benedict.



### 11AM COLUMBIA ROAD FLOWER MARKET

Every Sunday, Columbia Road is transformed into a colorful street market filled with flowers, shrubs, trees and plants, alongside vintage stores, cafés and art galleries. Peruse everything from vivid bedding plants to huge banana trees, before heading for a cupcake in a retro tea room.



### 3PM STREET ART BY BANKSY

Keep with the flower theme, but this time with a visit to an iconic piece of London street art, from the anonymous artist Banksy. This work entitled “Yellow Lines Flower Painter” and is widely considered to be an encouragement to break out of the lines and do something different.



### 5PM GODS OWN JUNKYARD

For more of London's diverse art scene, head out to God's Own Junkyard in Walthamstow. Set up by the artist, Chris Bracey, this neon warehouse houses his own work and his personal collection. After feasting your eyes, treat yourself to afternoon tea at the Rolling Scones café.



### 9PM ALL STAR BOWLING LANES

End the day at the All Star Bowling Lanes, a boutique bowling venue with a retro feel. After the game, celebrate your strikes with classic American dishes like buttermilk chicken or key lime pie. Later, sing your heart out in a private karaoke room or capture a memory in the in-house photo booth.
